

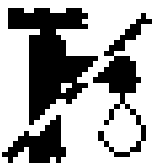
Dreamland Sea Thrift/ Sea Pinks



Armeria pseudarmeria 'Dreamland'

- **Use:** This cheery little flower is known as one of the easiest grown perennials. This beautiful breakthrough in Armeria breeding provides frost-to-frost flowering in containers or in the garden. Very heat tolerant and easy to grow. Good for container plantings, the rock garden, border, or as a ground cover. Excellent for edging or as a tightly spaced groundcover for mass color.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full to part sun. This plant tolerates drought and salt well and will grow in dry soils but prefers soil that is well-drained, loamy, sandy or clay with a neutral pH (7.0) so add a little lime and sand to our clay soils. Division should be performed in early spring and is necessary to rejuvenate the plant. Do not fertilize.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 12" tall, and round.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5a-9; Perennial. Very easy to grow!
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Creates a dome of green, blade-like leaves.
- **Flower:** The bright coral-pink drumstick flowers usher in spring and continue through frost. Remove old flowers once a month for best performance.

Well suited to rock gardens and dry stream beds. Perfect size for pots and troughs.
