Artemisia 'Silver Mound'

- **Use:** For a distinctive accent in borders or an unusual ground cover, we recommend this slinky silver foliage. Takes drought and cold, and aromatic oils make the leaves deer resistant. It also makes a fine addition to fresh or dried bouquets. A good companion for Mediterranean plants like Lavenders, Rosemary and Species Tulips.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Must have well drained soil. Water underneath the leaves.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 10-15" high and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-10 perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Deeply cut ferny compound leaves remain silver in color throughout the season.
- **Flower:** Has insignificant yellow flowers that appear in mid-summer.
