

# Olympia Sun Fern Wormwood



This unique herbaceous perennial works as a companion plant in containers or as an accent plant in the landscape.



## *Artemisia gmelinii* 'Olympia'

- **Use:** SunFern (although not a real fern) features fern-like textures that thrive in full to part sun. Low maintenance, drought tolerant, and winter hardy. Use it to add texture/ foliage interest in your flower beds and containers too.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun (here in zone 8 some afternoon shade would be ideal). Keep surface of soil moist, but not soggy. Likes a lot of water for fast growth.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 14-16" tall and 14-18" wide. (Non-invasive)
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4a-9a Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Feathery/ferny texture and upright form. Dark green leaves on red stems. Aromatic foliage.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
