Silky Gold Butterfly Weed







Asclepias curassavica 'Silky Gold'

- <u>Use:</u> An exotic yellow-flowered variety of tropical milkweed from South America. Asclepias flowers are nectar-rich and its leaves are an important food source for Monarch caterpillars. This easy care plant mixes beautifully with other tall perennials.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: They should be grown in well-drained soil in full sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Must have good drainage!
- Growth: Reaches 3 to 4 ft. tall and 2 to 3 ft. wide
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 8-11 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. This species has narrow 6 inch long lance-shaped leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Large clusters of golden-yellow summer flowers are displayed against yellow-green foliage.
