Astilbe 'Boogie Woogie'

- <u>Use:</u> Their dense, upright form is perfect in a dappled shade border, woodland garden, or as a groundcover. An excellent cut flower, fresh or dried. Tolerates drier soils than other varieties.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: <u>Prefers part sun (afternoon shade)!</u> Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established. Good drainage is important.
- **Growth:** Fast growing; reaches 14-16" tall and 24-30" wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 3-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter. Make sure they have well drained soil in the winter.
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Deer resistant! Foliage is deeply incised, coarsely textured, and dark green.
- <u>Flower:</u> Large upright dense plumes of bright florescent pink flowers are borne on narrow, branched panicles in summer. Plumes make excellent fresh cuts or for drying in natural bouquets.
