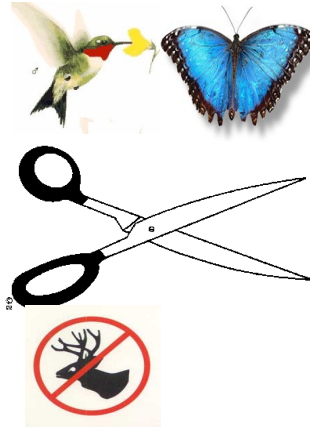

Astilbe 'Younique Series'

- **Use:** Astilbe Younique Series is a beautiful dwarf perennial that is ideal for the shady border or woodland garden. The Younique series of astilbe is known for profuse blooms that can be counted on for color and performance. Excellent for use as a cut flower, deer resistant, and attracts hummingbirds.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun! Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. **Keep soil moist** watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** This compact type grows 16-20" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter. Make sure they have well drained soil in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Deer resistant! Leaves are bronze-red in spring, turning mid-green by summer. Do not cut it back in the winter, but early spring.
- **Flower:** The floral display begins in early summer, and the spiked, frilly flowers add a soft contrast to other specimens in the garden. The dazzling flower spikes release a subtle sweet fragrance, and are set off beautifully by shiny dark green leaves.
