Deutschland Astilbe








Beautiful if used as a cut flower and attracts butterflies& humming-birds, yet is deer resistant.





Astilbe arendsii 'Deutschland'

- <u>Use:</u> Great for use in planters and in the garden! Excellent for use as a cutflower, deer resistant, and attracts hummingbirds.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: <u>Prefers part sun(afternoon shade preferred!)</u> Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. **Keep soil moist** watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** This compact type grows 20-22" tall and wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 3-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter. Make sure they have well drained soil in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Deer resistant! The foliage in spring is mahogany and turns to a dark glossy green. Do not cut it back in the winter, but early spring.
- <u>Flower:</u> Spires of feathery plumes in pure white are held well above the lush dark green glossy serrated leaves.
