

Purple Lance Astilbe



Astilbe arendsii 'Purple Lance'

- **Use:** Great for use in planters and in the garden! Excellent for use as a cutflower, deer resistant, and attracts hummingbirds. Also thrives in tubs, or mixed containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** **Prefers part sun!** Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. **Keep soil moist** watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** This taller type grows 3-4' tall and 2' wide.
- **Hardiness:** 3-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter. Make sure they have well drained soil in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Deer resistant! Leaves are bronze-red in spring, turning mid-green by summer. Do not cut it back in the winter, but early spring.
- **Flower:** This tall, late-blooming selection features showy, magenta-purple plumes, over a mound of elegant, lacy green leaves.



Beautiful if used as a cut flower and attracts butterflies & hummingbirds, yet is deer resistant.
