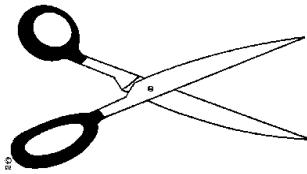


Vision Inferno Astilbe

Astilbe chinensis 'Vision Inferno'

- **Use:** A new addition to the Vision series from Future Plants; broadly upright and strong growth habit with dense 'flame like' cream to bluish pink plumes. Their dense, upright form is perfect in a dappled shade border, woodland garden, or as a groundcover. An excellent cut flower, fresh or dried. Tolerates drier soils than other varieties.
- **Exposure/Soil:** **Prefers part sun (afternoon shade)!** Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Fast growing; reaches 15-24 in. tall, 18*20 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter. Make sure they have well drained soil in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Deer resistant! Foliage is deeply incised, coarsely textured, and has a blue-green tint.
- **Flower:** Cream to bluish pink flowers are borne on narrow, branched panicles in summer.
