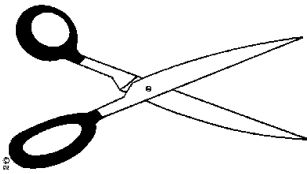


Vision In Pink Astilbe



Astilbe 'Vision in Pink'

- Attracts Pollinators
- Deer Resistant
- Walnut Toxicity Resistant
- Attracts Butterflies
- Cut Flower

- **Use:** The dense, upright form is perfect in a dappled shade border, woodland garden, or as a groundcover. An excellent cut flower, fresh or dried. Tolerates drier soils than other varieties.
- **Exposure/Soil:** **Prefers part sun!** Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Fast growing; reaches 24 to 32 in. tall, 12 to 24 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter. Make sure they have well drained soil in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Deer resistant! Foliage is deeply incised, coarsely textured, and has a blue-green tint.
- **Flower:** Light pink flowers are borne on narrow, branched panicles in summer.
