

Decadence® Blueberry Sundae False Indigo



Baptisia h. 'Blueberry Sundae' PP23891

- **Use:** Vibrant indigo blue spires produce an excellent floral display atop the compact, upright mound of blue-green foliage. This vigorous native cultivar looks great in the garden all season.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full–part sun. Tolerate poor, sandy soils and some drought, but resent having their roots disturbed. Drainage is a must so please amend clay soils.
- **Growth:** Grows 30-36” tall and 3’ wide. Plants may be increased by dividing in spring, every 4 to 5 years, or by moving any seedlings that may appear, while they are still small.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9 Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Lobed leaves.
- **Flower:** Deep indigo blue flowers much more vibrant than *B. australis* and a perfect plant habit are the key features of this new variety. An excellent floral display occurs in late spring to early summer. Secondary flower spikes extend the flowering time into mid-summer. In fall they turn into large charcoal black seed pods in late summer that are often used in flower arrangements.
