

Winter Glow Hardy Begonia/ Pigsqueak



An excellent, deer resistant woodland plant for shaded areas. Kids love to rub the leaves together and make a squeaking sound like a pig.

***Bergenia cordifolia* 'Winterglut'**

- **Use:** This plant is noted for its beautiful bronze fall-winter foliage. Its leaves are rounded to heart-shaped and sometimes puckered, growing to about 12 inches. Useful in woodland or shady beds. Beloved for its ability to take heavy shade.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plants are happy in any shady area that stays relatively moist, but well-drained. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-18" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial;
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Glossy green leaves squeak when rubbed together. Striking, red-painted winter foliage that chases the chill from a December day.
- **Flower:** It bears saturated magenta flowers on red stalks in late winter to early spring.
