Brugmansia 'Ecuador Pink'

- **Use:** Brugmansia teaches us the meaning of such words as "profusion" and "fragrance." The richness of color catches the eye, the intense fragrance delights the nose and the profuse blooms add joy to any living space.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun-part shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Always thirsty for water and hungry for fertilizer. Recommend lots of water and a hot location SW exposure. After 1st light frost in fall cut back to 1-2' tall and cover with an upside down bucket and mulch. You may store the cut canes in a bucket with a few inches of water in a frost-free garage over the winter and then plant them outdoors in other areas in the spring.
- **Growth:** Will grow 3-6' tall and spreads slowly up to 3' wide. Depends on variety.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7b-10 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; green foliage
- **Flower:** Fragrant, pink, large blossoms hang down and bloom May until fall frost.
