- **Use:** 'Alexander's Great' has finally met its match. 'Alexandria' is the perfect companion to our favorite Siberian Brunnera. Alexandria features brilliant mirror-silver leaves with the classic 'Alexander's Great' size and vigor. Tiny clouds of sky-blue flowers in the spring float above the foliage as it emerges. Truly a refreshing garden addition with early flowers for the pollinators. Use in foundation plantings, shade gardens, mass plantings, front or middle of the border, urban gardens, containers
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plants are happy in any shady area that stays relatively moist, but well-drained. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 14" tall by 12-24" wide. 17" tall in bloom.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial; Often will self-seed and appear around the garden in other places.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Large heart-shaped leaves of silvery white. Its silver leaves look like a master silversmith created a treasure right in the middle of the garden. Its shiny leaves are perfectly outlined in emerald green.
- **Flower:** Delicate sprays of starry blue flowers dance above on graceful stems, offering a soothing yet vibrant presence in a shady spot.
