***Brunnera macropylla* 'Emerald Mist'**

- **Use:** A number of excellent new forms of Brunnera have been introduced in recent years, and 'Emerald Mist' is no exception. An obvious improvement over 'Langtrees', this new sport of 'Jack Frost' has more silver barring with the bars connecting to form a silver collar around the perimeter of the leaf. In addition, there is a very light dusting of silver over the entire leaf surface. Brunneras are classic perennials that are treasured for their shade tolerance and lovely blooms. They make a fantastic groundcover, though the variegated forms may be slower to spread than the species. Try growing them in containers too so they will be close at hand when you want to snip a few blooms for a spring bouquet.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plants are happy in any shady area that stays relatively moist, but well-drained. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 14-17"(in flower) tall by 24" wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial; Often will self-seed and appear around the garden in other places.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Splashes of antique silver mist over emerald green hearts create a distinctive addition to your garden. Like a jeweler's best work this elegant, NEW Brunnera, is a garden gem.
- **Flower:** Delicate sprays of starry blue flowers dance above on graceful stems, offering a soothing yet vibrant presence in a shady spot.
