An excellent, deer resistant woodland plant for shaded areas.



***Brunnera macropylla* 'Jack Frost'**

- **Use:** 2012 Perennial Plant Association's Plant of the Year. Prized for its large highly frosted and veined heart-shaped leaves. Produces a truly spectacular display in the shade, even more so when in bloom with its bright blue Forget-me-not flowers in spring. Will multiply politely. Try this plant in your shade garden. Use in foundation plantings, shade gardens, mass plantings, front or middle of the border, urban gardens, containers
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plants are happy in any shady area that stays relatively moist, but well-drained. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 15" tall by 15" wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial; Often will self-seed and appear around the garden in other places.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Dark green leaves have heavily frosted overlay that shows only the green veining.
- **Flower:** Delicate sprays of starry blue flowers dance above on graceful stems, offering a soothing yet vibrant presence in a shady spot.
