

Silver Heart Siberian Bugloss



***Brunnera macropylla* 'Silver Heart'**

- **Use:** Not all variegated plants can boast the sophisticated beauty displayed by this one's lovely foliage. The blooms are deep cobalt blue and the foliage is as silver as a baracuda's skin. Try this plant in your shade garden. Use in foundation plantings, shade gardens, mass plantings, front or middle of the border, urban gardens, containers
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plants are happy in any shady area that stays relatively moist, but well-drained. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 6-12" tall by 12-24" wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial; Often will self-seed and appear around the garden in other places.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Thick, durable foliage, silver with intricate green lacy veins and green margins, lights up a shady spot. Although the foliage is similar to 'Looking Glass', this new selection has much thicker, non-melting foliage and deep blue flowers, and superior nematode resistance.
- **Flower:** Delicate sprays of starry blue flowers dance above on graceful stems, offering a soothing yet vibrant presence in a shady spot.

An excellent, deer resistant woodland plant for shaded areas.
