## Campanula portenschlagiana

- <u>Use:</u> This low growing, clump forming campanula will delight has tons of purple-blue flowers throughout the summer, this selection doesn't need vernalization to bloom, first F1 hybrid Campanula from seed, will repeat bloom during the fall. Flows beautifully along bed edges and through rock gardens. Excellent as a groundcover. Attracts butterflies and deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full–part sun (morning sun 6+hours and afternoon shade best). Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter. Loves moist soil conditions.
- Growth: Grows to 8-10" tall and wide
- *Hardiness: Zone* 3-8; Perennial.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. The foliage remains evergreen in mild winters and needs to be sheared only once in a while to keep its appearance tidy.
- <u>Flower:</u> Creating a stream of lavender blue, the star-shaped blossoms bloom reliably from late spring to early fall.
