Campanula poscharskyana 'Camgood"

- <u>Use:</u> This low growing, clump forming campanula will delight has tons of purple-blue flowers throughout the summer. Flows beautifully along bed edges and through rock gardens. Excellent as a groundcover. Attracts butterflies and deer resistant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers morning sun and afternoon shade in our area (morning sun 6+hours). Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter. Prefers slightly moist soils and part sun, we have found its tolerance for dry shade pretty good.
- Growth: Grows to 8-12" tall and 18-24" wide
- *Hardiness: Zone* 4-7b; Perennial.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. The foliage remains evergreen in mild winters and needs to be sheared only once in a while to keep its appearance tidy.
- *Flower:* Creating a stream of lavender blue, the star-shaped blossoms bloom reliably from late spring to early fall.
