

White Wonder Campanula



Campanula x haylodgensis 'White Wonder'

- **Use:** Enjoy these beauties indoors to chase away cloudy winter day doldrums. Then after last frost in spring plant them outdoors. This showy variety is perfect for rock gardens, edging, or in containers; loads of white double bluebell-like flowers begin in early summer and bloom for weeks on end; a vigorous grower that is great as a small area groundcover Use these plants to line borders or in mass plantings for a head turning display.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Place near a window where it will receive ample sunlight (at least 6 hours a day of direct sunlight on the plant). A south-facing window is usually best. Water under leaves. Keep the potting mix moist, but do not allow the pot to sit in water for more than an hour. It's time to water when the top ½ inch of the potting mix feels dry to the touch. Outdoors in Zone 8 they prefer a little afternoon shade after 3pm to protect from the heat.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 8 to 12" tall and 16-28" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial. Plant outdoors in spring after last fall frost.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Forms delicate green leaves.
- **Flower:** Normally mothered in stunning white bell-shaped flowers at the ends of the stems from early to late summer if outdoors. If desired, trim plants back to 4 inches after flowering, to rejuvenate the foliage and tidy up for the remainder of the season.

Enjoy indoors or outdoors. This gorgeous delicate flower is a compliment to any garden. Although no plant is completely deer proof this perennial is considered to be deer resistant. A favorite for cottage and butterfly gardens.
