Chrysanthemum 'Firedance Igloo'

- **Use:** Truly hardy perennials. Plants are covered in fluffy blooms flowers of for over a month. First-year flowering. Bloom usually begins in September first year, August in subsequent years. Attractive lobed green leaves form uniform, rounded masses without pinching. The Igloo series brings unprecedented uniformity and flower power to the late Summer/early Autumn perennial border. Pinching in June will help to keep plants bushy and compact. Attracts butterflies to the garden and lovely in late season bouquets. Exceptionally hardy and easy to grow.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to light shade. Moist well draining soil is best. Heavy feeder when actively growing.
- **Growth:** Grows to 16-18" tall and 18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Attractive lobed green leaves form uniform rounded masses without pinching
- **Flower:** Plants are covered in hot red daisy petals that "dance" around a striking yellow eye. Uniform mounding plants. Bloom begins in Sept. first year. Aug. or earlier in subsequent years
