

Raspberry Sorbet Chrysanthemum



Chrysanthemum (Dendanthremum) 'Raspberry Sorbet'

- **Use:** This hardy garden mum offers showy blooms of bright and cheerful pink/purple with incredible fragrance. It is covered with dozens of different pollinators when there is little else out there blooming in the fall garden. Fabulous! Like all of the hardy garden mums this plant is a reliable perennial year after year and will be one of the last plants flowering in your garden in the fall.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to light shade. Moist well draining soil is best. Tolerates late shade.
- **Growth:** Grows to 24-30" tall and 24-30" wide. To prevent flop trim a couple of times in early and mid-summer to encourage branching
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Lacy green leaves.
- **Flower:** Purple buds unfold to pinkish-purple flowers in late October. Blooms continue for weeks providing summer color late in the season and a stunning sight if caught in the first snowfall.
