Chrysogonum virginianum 'Pierre'

- **Use:** Low-growing, mat-forming plant similar in structure to Ajuga. Needs ample water in full sun. Requires afternoon shade in warmer climates. It spreads by rooting runners to form an attractive groundcover that is easily controlled. This variety differs from the species in its more prostrate form and its more rapid spread. Grow in woodland gardens, native plant gardens, or naturalized areas. Makes a good edge for woodland paths.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plants are happy in any shady area that stays relatively moist, but well-drained. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 6-10" tall and 1 to 3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** 3-8; Perennial; Often will self-seed and appear around the garden in other places.
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Small green leaves.
- **Flower:** Showy yellow blooms spring through from May to October. Remove spent flowers for best appearance. May self-seed.

An excellent, deer resistant woodland plant for shaded areas.
