Colocasia esculenta 'Black Coral'

- **Use:** Royal Hawaiian® Black Coral Elephant Ear's attractive enormous heart-shaped leaves remain burgundy in color with showy black variegation and tinges of dark red throughout the season.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part shade. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. The more water and fertilizer they get the better. Could grow in a well aerated pond.
- **Growth:** Will grow to be about 4 feet tall at maturity, with a spread of 3 feet.
- **Hardiness:** 7b-10, perennial, mulch 1' around plant in fall
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Deep burgundy-black leaves are one of the darkest grown
- **Flower:** Neither the flowers nor the fruit are ornamentally significant.
