

# Black Magic Elephant Ears



## *Colocasia esculenta* 'Black Magic'

- **Use:** This elephant ear that could only be described as AWESOME!!!! This is a four exclamation point plant if there ever was one.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part shade. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. The more water and fertilizer they get the better. Could grow in a well aerated pond.
- **Growth:** It makes a giant clump to 5-6' tall with a similar spread.
- **Hardiness:** 7b-10, perennial, mulch 1' around plant in fall
- **Foliage:** The dusty solid purple-black leaves to 2' long make this elephant ear one of the most spectacular forms ever introduced! Looks great against chartreuse.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
