

Mojito Elephant Ears



You'll never see an elephant ear as unique and striking as the Mojito. The leaves have a camouflage-like pattern with splashes of deep purple.

Colocasia esculenta 'Black Sapphire Gecko'

- **Use:** This striking elephant ear features vivid lime green foliage heavily splashed and blotched with deep black markings, creating dramatic natural contrast. The petioles are equally eye-catching, displaying shades of dark pink to creamy white accented with black streaking. This is a four exclamation point plant if there ever was one. Adds a great backdrop for other flowers to pop!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Thrives in full to partial sun. Some afternoon shade is beneficial to prevent scorching, but too much shade can limit color development. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. As heavy feeders, they benefit from regular fertilization with a balanced, high-nitrogen fertilizer. Could grow in a well aerated pond.
- **Growth:** It makes a giant clump to 3-5' tall and 3-4' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7b-11, Perennial, mulch 1' around plant in fall
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Large (1-2' long), heart-shaped lime-green leaves heavily mottled with deep purple-black spots and streaked petioles.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
