## *Colocasia esculenta* 'Waikiki' PP34615

- **Use:** Royal Hawaiian® 'Waikiki' offers glossy green foliage with flamboyant white and flamingo pink veining. Its compact, clumping habit – 3 feet tall and wide – is ideal for patio containers and in the garden. Waikiki is part of the Royal Hawaiian series and produces these striking colors earlier than other variegated leaf Colocasia. The deep burgundy stems produce a lush, compact plant that holds up well even in wind and rain. What a way to bring a touch of the tropics to your garden, no matter where you are located!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part shade. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. The more water and fertilizer they get the better. Could grow in a well aerated pond.
- **Growth:** It makes a giant clump to 3' tall with a similar spread.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11, perennial, mulch 1' around plant in fall
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Sturdy, large glossy leaves that unfurled with a bold leaf coloration featuring pink veins and creamy white centers.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
