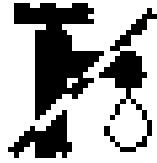


# Coreopsis American Dream



## *Coreopsis rosea* 'American Dream'

- **Use:** Looks great with any type of grass, in borders or mass plantings in sunny gardens. The only coreopsis with pink flowers resembles asters. Soft, fern-like foliage provides airy appearance. American native hybrid is drought tolerant, deer resistant and attracts butterflies. Looks great planted with grasses.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter. Prefers well drained sites where it spreads by rhizome and self seeding.
- **Growth:** Grows has a plant height of 18" and a spread of 10-12".
- **Hardiness:** 5-10 perennial. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The dark green thread leaf foliage makes a great contrast with the flower color.
- **Flower:** Produces heavy crops of rosy daisies with yellow center. Flowers over a long season from mid summer through fall



**Super tough, deer resistant, and drought tolerant once established.**
