

Coreopsis verticillata 'Crème Caramel'

- <u>Use:</u> A wonderful new hybrid of C. grandiflora x verticillata from Long Island, NY. It is similar to 'Moonbeam' but is more prolific, producing larger flowers and displaying improved mildew resistance.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full-part sun It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter. . Prefers well drained sites where it spreads by rhizome and self seeding.
- - *Hardiness:* Zone 5-10 Perennial. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- **plant will pro- Foliage:** Deciduous. The dark green thread-like foliage makes a great contrast with the flowers.
- Iong-lasting cut flower bouquets all summer long.
 Flower: Soft yellow blooms cover the compact mounds of bright green, threadleaf foliage from early thru late summer. Cutting this plant back by 1/3 to 1/2 after its first flush of flowers is finished will extend the bloom period into fall.
