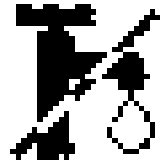


# Golden Starburst Coreopsis/Tickseed



## ***Coreopsis 'Golden Starburst'***

- **Use:** Held above grassy green lanceolate foliage, they'll create a low carpet of high-impact bloom from summer through fall. We love to plant them in front of grasses for a drought resistant and easy perennial border. Deer resistant. It attracts butterflies and bees and is heat and frost tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter. Can divide easily in spring.
- **Growth:** Grows of 12-14" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5a-9b; Perennial. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The dark green, narrow lance shaped foliage makes a great contrast with the flower color. Mildew resistant.
- **Flower:** Solitary, yellow, semi-double, 1-2" daisy-like flowers with yellow rays and darker yellow center disks atop slender, erect stems rising 18-24" tall. Flowers typically bloom from late spring into fall. Removing faded flowers regularly will extend the bloom season.
