
Red Satin Coreopsis





This beautiful deep red rebloomer starts off the brand new Permathread™ series. With dense, dark green foliage, the suntolerant Red Satin Coreopsis will add depth and interest to the garden all season long.

Coreopsis 'Red Satin'

- <u>Use:</u> More compact than some Coreopsis, this tidy little superstar tops out at 15-18 inches high and 18-22 inches wide, so it's just the right size for almost any spot in the garden. Tough and hearty, this red lovely will withstand heat, drought, and poor soil conditions, making it a can't-lose choice for the color border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full–part sun It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter. . Prefers well drained sites where it spreads by rhizome and self seeding.
- **Growth:** Height of 15-18" and a spread of 18-24". It should be cut backing early and late summer to extend the bloom period.
- *Hardiness: Zone* 5-9 perennial. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. The dark green thread-like foliage makes a great contrast with the flowers.
- <u>Flower:</u> Gorgeous wine red flowers with wonderfully contrasting golden centers spring forth from tightly mounded foliage beginning in summer and if cut back promptly following the initial show, wave after wave of 1½-inch blooms will continue to grace your garden right up until frost.
