

Dwarf Eared Coreopsis



Coreopsis auriculata 'Nana'

- **Use:** Small bright yellow flowers are held above handsome clumps of low, dark green foliage with distinctive lobed ears. Excellent for rock gardens, edging, or for mass planting.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter.
- **Growth:** Grows has a plant height of 24" and a spread of 10-12".
- **Hardiness:** 5-10 perennial. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The dark green thread leaf foliage makes a great contrast with the flower color.
- **Flower:** Yellow flowers bloom June through October. It should be cut backing early and late summer to extend the bloom period.

Super tough and drought tolerant once established.
