Coreopsis grandiflora 'Early Sunrise'

- **Use:** Coreopsis 'Early Sunrise' looks great with any type of grass, in borders or mass plantings in sunny gardens. So easy to grow and it is deer and drought tolerant. Attracts butterflies. Winner of Gold medals in America and Europe. Superb in the border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter.
- **Growth:** Grows has a plant height of 24" and a spread of 10-12".
- **Hardiness:** 5-10 perennial. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The dark green thread leaf foliage makes a great contrast with the flower color.
- **Flower:** This All-American Selections Gold Metal Award Winner has double yellow flowers flush to orange-yellow near the center and bloom June through October. It should be cut backing early and late summer to extend the bloom period.
