Super tough and drought tolerant once established.

Coreopsis grandiflora 'Bright Touch'

- <u>Use:</u> A compact but showy blast of color for sunny borders or containers. Bright golden yellow flowers with a touch of red on strong, short stems rise slightly above upright mounds of lush green foliage, and continue to bloom throughout summer, even in hot and humid climates! An occasional pinching is required to promote reblooming.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full–part sun It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter. Can divide easily in spring.
- *Growth:* Grows has a plant height of 10-12" and a spread of 10-12".
- *Hardiness:* Zone 4-9; Perennial. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. The dark green foliage makes a great contrast with the flower color.
- <u>Flower:</u> Many upright stems of large bicolor red and yellow blooms with rich, orange centers. Blooms continuously from early spring through late fall. Removing faded flowers regularly will extend the bloom season.
