

Double the Sun Coreopsis/Tickseed



***Coreopsis grandiflora* 'Double the Sun'**

- **Use:** This hardy perennial offers excellent heat and drought tolerance once established in the garden. Shows off big, semi-double flowers in a bright solid yellow when planted in full sun. An occasional pinching is required to promote re-blooming. The 12-15 in. tall, nicely shaped, easy to grow plants begin to bloom during cool spring weather and continue to flower heavily through the heat of summer.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter. Can divide easily in spring.
- **Growth:** Grows has a plant height of 12-15" tall and a spread of 12-12".
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The dark green foliage makes a great contrast with the flower color.
- **Flower:** Big clear golden yellow, semi double, 2½ in. flowers from sprin to summer. Double the Sun coreopsis brings a long season of low maintenance color to the front of your borders, flower beds and planters, and along garden paths.
