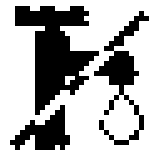


Threadleaf Coreopsis



Coreopsis verticillata

- **Use:** Use in natural and pollinator borders. Also effective in naturalized areas, native plant gardens or cottage gardens. Good plant for areas with poor, dry soils. This is a native straight species from seed.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter. . Prefers well drained sites where it spreads by rhizome and self seeding.
- **Growth:** Height of 2.5'3' tall and a spread of 18-24". It should be cut backing early and late summer to extend the bloom period.
- **Hardiness:** 3-9 Perennial. Reseeding Very heat and drought tolerant!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The dark green thread-like foliage makes a great contrast with the flowers.
- **Flower:** Sunny yellow flowers bloom heavily from June through August, with repeat bloom till frost. Plants may be sheared in mid to late summer to promote a fall rebloom and to remove any sprawling or unkempt foliage. Species plants can spread somewhat aggressively in the garden by both rhizomes and self-seeding.
