- **Use:** Unlike the fire engine-red blooms of the common Crocosmia, George Davison boasts gorgeous, butter yellow blooms. Try planting both varieties together for a stunning, contrasting display of color. Try it as cut flowers or as a border plant in your perennial garden and it is also a major attractor to butterflies. Deer resistant and drought tolerant!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 16-18" tall and 2' wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; long, thin grass-like leaves.
- **Flower:** Spectacular, butter yellow blooms on tall, singular stems. Perfect for cutting and bringing inside for gorgeous bouquets.
