

Sharona™ Crocosmia



Crocosmia 'Sharona'

- **Use:** Coral-pink flowers, each with a twinkle of gold at its heart, line the slender, arching stems of Crocosmia Sharona™, adding the romantic colors of a Caribbean sunset to the garden. The tubular blooms appear in sprays above blade-shaped foliage, and they provide a feast for hummingbirds. The flower stems can be cut to make lovely additions to summer bouquets. In autumn, the seed pods provide food for birds.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** 'Lucifer' has a plant height of 36-42" and a plant spread of 30-36".
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Blade-shaped foliage.
- **Flower:** Stands out from other Crocosmias with unique hot coral flowers. Like its relatives, the bright blooms unfurl from elegant arching stems. The elaborate flower displays bring bold beauty, and plenty of pollinators, to your yard. A hit with hummingbirds, plant 'Sharona' as a focal point in your garden or along the edges of a walkway where its beauty can be appreciated.
