Super tough and drought tolerant once established.

Cuphea hyssopifolia

- **Exposure/Soil:** This unique and very hardy plant can be grown at any light level. It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter.
- **Growth:** Grows to 1-2' tall and wide in one season.
- **Hardiness:** 7b-10 tender perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter. May plant in the ground in spring and they will come following year back in a protected area with a good mulch layer before winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small leaves.
- **Flower:** Thousands of small blossoms cover this plant from mid May until October. Be patient as the plant doesn't emerge next year until late May.
