## ***Dahlinova 'Hypnotica Series'***

- **Use:** The hybrids in the Hypnotica® Series are compact, mounding, heavy-flowering and come in an array of colors. Their flowers are double to semi-double. Nothing beats dahlias as ever-blooming bedding plants and cut flowers. Attracts hummingbirds and is deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Loves sun, but will take a little afternoon shade. Needs at least 5-6 hours of direct sunlight. Mulch well in the fall. Do not touch canes until following spring. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 16" tall and 16" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11; Tender perennial, needs protected location.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Small spade shaped leaves.
- **Flower:** An array of radiant blooms will capture eyes in any garden month after month, despite the weather. Elegant flowers attract butterflies and are great for cutting. It is good to remove the buds with spent flowers to encourage continued flowering.
