

# Granita Raspberry Ice Plant



## *Delosperma 'Granita Raspberry'*

Comes back every year, deer resistant, heat tolerant, and drought tolerant.

- **Use:** Have your granita and eat it too! This high performing new ice plant, like it's kin GRANITA® Orange, closely hugs the ground, vigorously spreads and is densely covered with large flowers in varying shades of raspberry red that are at once bright, earthy and iridescent. A beautiful way to enhance your garden, provide nectar for bees, and save water at the same time.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun(5 or more hours). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Allow soil to be slightly dry between waterings. Must have well-drained soil. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Low growing plants grow 1-2" tall and to 15-18" wide or more.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. When not in bloom, the small, needle-like succulent foliage of brightest green reaches just 1 to 2 inches high.
- **Flower:** The large shimmering raspberry-red flowers will be the highlight of your late spring garden when this durable groundcover comes into bloom.
