The WoW Delosperma flower continuously from early summer to early winter. Have you planted WoW in your garden? You can easily go on a holiday for weeks. They can be without water for a long time. When you come back from holiday, the flowers will still be blooming in your garden. WoW Limoncello is perfect as solitary on terrace or balcony, in rock gardens, perennial borders, roof gardens, combined planting and as flowering groundcover.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in full sun to partial sun(5 or more hours). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Allow soil to be slightly dry between waterings. Must have well-drained sandy, soil. Red clay or packed soils is a death sentence. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** It grows to 6" high and 20" wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 6b-9; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. When not in bloom, the small, needle-like succulent foliage of brightest green reaches just 6" inches high.
- <u>Flower:</u> White and yellow flowers late spring to fall frosts. It's a magnet for bees and butterflies. . You just won't believe the bloom strength of this perennial groundcover powerhouse!
