Delosperma cooperi 'Lavender Ice'

- **Use:** This beauty has large, gorgeous lavender-pink flowers and a tidy mat of evergreen foliage that turns purplish in winter. Drought resistant/drought tolerant plant (xeric). Hardy, succulent gray-green foliage is ideal for borders, hillsides, rock gardens and other tough sites.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun (5 or more hours). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Allow soil to be slightly dry between waterings. Must have well-drained soil. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Low growing plants grow 2-4" tall and to 2-3 ft wide or more.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** Lavender daisy-like blooms from May– October.
