

Dark Blue/white Delphinium Planter



Delphinium elatum 'Magic Fountain Dark Blue White Bee'

- **Use:** Easy to grow in full sun, and attracts butterflies as well as hummingbirds. Nibbling rabbits and deer leave it alone, and it makes excellent cut-flowers, whether fresh or dried. This sun-lover appreciates deadheading to stimulate rebloom. But be sure to leave the final flowers of the season on the plant, so it can self-sow!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in part sun in our area, full sun up North. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers. If you are not good at watering we recommend using **Soil Moist**.
- **Growth:** Grows 14-18" tall and 1' wide. Shorter height means less likely to need staking
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-7, Tender Perennial/ Reseeding Annual Heat may be hard on them in summer. Save seeds for following year to resow.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Finely cut leaves.
- **Flower:** Big double blooms of dark blue with a bold white bee (central cluster of petals). It blooms heavily in late spring and early summer, and then sometimes repeats! Lovely as a cut flower.

Stately and breathtaking. Magnificent dense racemes make delphinium excellent in the border and as a cutflower.
