

Diamonds Blue Larkspur



Stately and breathtaking. Magnificent dense racemes make larkspur excellent in the border and as a cut flower.



Delphinium grandiflorum 'Diamonds Blue'

- **Use:** Very different from the traditional tall spiky Delphiniums, this strain forms a low, bushy mound of lacy green leaves. Plants bear loose sprays of single blooms all summer long, in a gorgeous electric blue shade featuring a purple spot on each petal. Ideal for containers, the rock garden and for edging the sunny border. Remove faded flower heads regularly to encourage repeat blooming. More tolerant of hot, humid summer climates.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in morning sun and afternoon shade in our area, full sun up North. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers. If you are not good at watering we recommend using **Soil Moist**.
- **Growth:** Foliage reaches 12 to 18 in. tall, 18 in wide, with blooms to 24 in. tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9, Although not a long-lived perennial, this will often self sow where happy.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Finely cut leaves.
- **Flower:** Produces upward-facing, spurless, cerulean blue flowers that appear on first-year plants, sure to win your admiration. Delphiniums are magnificent in a border, and we suggest you plant at least a few in the cutting garden, for the spikes, if cut when a quarter of the flowers are open, last a week in water.
