Dianthus 'Coronet Series'

• Use: Non-stop flowers from October until April! Very long blooming throughout the year almost! Tons of flowers on a compact, mounded plant. Performs best in cool weather. Plant along with other cool-season annuals such as pansies for best flowering. A good addition to the front border or used as an edging along a walk way. Will bloom for many vears!

• Exposure/Soil: Plant in full sun to part sun. Moderate water requirements, but somewhat drought tolerant. Must amend the soil if you have poor soil (like red clay). We recommend the Pro Mix Soil.

Growth: Full sized plants grow to 8-10" tall and wide.

• Hardiness: Zones 5a-9; A cool-season annual (actually a biennial or short-lived perennial (2-3 years at least though). It will bloom in spring and fall, often going dormant during summer in warm climates. In our warm summers, it will rest, but may go into winter despite light frosts. Either way, it is long-blooming and beautiful in any setting!

- Foliage: Evergreen. Small dark green narrow leaves.
- *Flower:* Extra-large, 2 to 3 in. blooms dominate the 8-10 in. basalbranching plants, in a blaze of showy colors. Long bloom time.
