

Dash Crimson Dianthus



Dianthus barbatus 'Dash Crimson'

- **Use:** Produces a shocking blaze of super-charged color all summer long. Mixes magnificently with celosia, rudbeckia and echinacea in the front of the sunny border; downright awesome in a container. Attractively mass in the landscape, midborder, or a favorite container on the patio. Produces baskets of ultra-violet cut-flowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to part sun. Moderate water requirements, but somewhat drought tolerant. Must amend the soil if you have poor soil (like red clay). We recommend the Pro Mix Soil.
- **Growth:** Full sized plants grow to 16-20" inches tall and 12-14" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 6-11; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; glossy dark green leaves
- **Flower:** Ablaze with crimson, lightly fragrant, high-saturation blooms—producing bouquet after bouquet of dazzling cut flowers.

Nonstop blaze of showy, crimson-fringy blooms non-stop from spring into fall.
