Dianthus 'Early Bird Sherbert'

- **Use:** Starts flowering at the end of February, and if you remove the spent blooms, they will continue to rebloom right through to fall. They make excellent subjects for window boxes, baskets or planters. Long blooming time of 5+ months! Highly valued rock garden plant or tightly spaced as edging and masses. Small size and long blooming color is perfect for troughs and pots. Essential to cottage garden and perennial border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 5-8" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Plants produce a low, dense mound of attractive silvery blue-gray foliage.
- **Flower:** Features large magenta fully double flowers on a compact plant. With deadheading, it's a long-bloomer that graces the garden with flowers from spring to fall.
