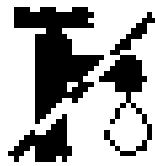


Eastern Star Dianthus



Dianthus 'Eastern Star'

- **Use:** Long blooming time of 4-5 months! Highly valued rock garden plant or tightly spaced as edging and masses. Small size and long blooming color is perfect for troughs and pots. Essential to cottage garden and perennial border. Dianthus Eastern Star is one of the best when it comes to Dianthus. Selected for prolific blooms, intense fragrance, numerous flowers, beautiful foliage - you can't go wrong with this tough, durable Drought Tolerant Ground Cover
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** The habit is compact and mounding to a height of about 7" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 4-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** The evergreen, glaucous grey-green foliage provides a stark contrast for these shockingly bright flowers.
- **Flower:** Hundreds of shocking red flowers with dark centers that face upward so you can enjoy them even more! Though budding is most prolific in early summer, plants rebloom in the fall when old flowers are pruned off.

Very easy to grow and low maintenance! FRAGRANT!
