

Dianthus Firewitch



Dianthus 'Firewitch'

- **Use:** Long blooming time of 4-5 months! Highly valued rock garden plant or tightly spaced as edging and masses. Small size and long blooming color is perfect for troughs and pots. Essential to cottage garden and perennial border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 6-12" tall x 12" wide and continues to spread by underground shoots.
- **Hardiness:** 4-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Plants produce a low, dense mound of attractive green-gray foliage.
- **Flower:** Blooms in late spring over about 10 weeks with small single, stunning magenta pink fragrant flowers. Repeat blooms if promptly sheared after spring flush.

Very easy to grow and low maintenance! FRAGRANT!
